We invite citizens from neighborhood associations, social service agencies, nonprofit shelter organizations, rental property owners, and other stakeholders for a well-rounded discussion about Bloomington's affordable housing stock and the need for emergency shelter options.

Notes from the comments made during this town hall meeting will be used by the Community and Family Resource Commissioners for future focus groups on the topic of housing and homelessness.

Lending to a comprehensive needs assessment, we hope these discussions will lead to thoughtful solutions and guidance for public policy recommendations in meeting affordable housing demands.
